Fermentation	Grapes are destemmed and put in open air tanks with temperature control system; total day of fermentation process is 16 days with a max temperature of 28 °C. The grapes are inoculated with selected indigenous yeasts.
Ageing	The wine ages 16/18 months mainly in used barrique. A 12-month aging period in bottle follows.

Production in bottles	6000(750ml); 120(1,5lt); 30 (3 lt); 10(6 lt)
Alcohol level	14,50%
Tasting Notes	Pure Sangiovese grapes chosen in the Gugliaie vineyard for this wine dedicated to Anna Corsini, a tribute to a special woman that try to translate in the glass her character and personality. The 2015 vintage, with its generous climate, has brought the brightness with full maturity of Sangiovese into an intense and charming wine. The aromatic profile is intense and floral, with dried mint and thyme on rich fruits, such as cherry and plum, raspberry and red orange. The sip is complex and appealing in its balanced dynamics between the power of the structure and a juicy freshness, together with spicy and salty notes, shaded of graphite and leather. Vibrant velvet tannins give a remarkable persistence and a bright balsamic finish.
